Common Issues



What we Commonly See

Your Crawlspace is an entity that should be maintained by a trained professional who understand the effects of moisture here on the jersey Shore. Our experts usually find issues hidden from a standard inspection and offers 22 points of inspection.

Heres What we commonly see:

Mold & High Relative Humidity

Mold, fungi and high relative humidity are the most common negative conditions discovered on Home Inspections here on the shore.

The moist environment coupled with high ground water and coastal flooding events are the most frequent culprits leading to issues such as this. These homes are often lacking encapsulation components or drainage systems to combat these conditions.

Flooding & Standing Water

Drainage and Grading problems can wreak havoc on a crawlspace and basement. Many homes require a french drain, sump pumps, or other measures to combat the water in within the crawlspace and basement.

Missing, or Thin Vapor Barrier

Many Jersey Shore homes were built many years ago, and do not possess an adequate vapor barrier. A proper vapor barrier is essential to minimize water vapor that rises from the soil and can lead to mold growth and damage to the insulation

Wet, Sub-Par or Falling Insulation

When Fiberglass insulation gets wet, it loses its retention value (R-Value). When this happens, the insulation does not do it's job and can lead to hefty increases in energy spending.

We use the Encapsulated Floor Insulation for our replacements which comes housed in a poly vapor retarder which protects it from the moist environment.

Drainage Services



French Drains

An interior French drain consists of a trench dug around the perimeter of your crawlspace. (Extensive Warranty)



Sump Pump

Our sump pumps consist of 1/3 HP-3/4 HP and battery backup. The sump pump diverts water that gets in the crawlspace away from your home. (Extensive warranty)



Grading/ Drainage Matting

For crawl spaces with large dips or unlevel surfaces and is usually used in conjunction with a vapor barrier.
